(b) How has God fulfilled that promise in your life?

Q.6 Why do you think Jesus used three different words ("ask", "seek", "knock") in Matthew 7:7?

Q.7 How did Jesus sum up the fulfilment of God's scriptural commands in Matthew 7:12?
